

Announcing of the Gospel - With others (AM II, 5, 16,26)

Dear sisters and brothers, on this day as we tend towards the end of our encounter, we want to focus our attention on Christ the Master through his word in a deep prayer, so that the Lord Himself may grant us the spiritual strengths to live what we have experienced during this time.

Let us pray that the Lord will grant us the grace of his presence in our lives, the love of mission and the gift of prayer to make our apostolats well.

In this tranquility, let us listen to the Master through his gospel: Mc 6:7-13

At that time, Jesus called the Twelve; so he began to send them on a two-by-two mission. He gave them authority over unclean spirits, and he ordered them to take nothing for the road, but only a stick, no bread, no bag, no coins in their belts. "Put on sandals, don't take a spare tunic." He told them again: "When you have found hospitality in a house, stay there until you leave. If, in a locality, they refuse to welcome you and listen to you, leave and shake the dust of your feet: it will be a testimony to them." They left and proclaimed that they had to convert. They expelled many demons, made oil anointings to many sick people, and healed them.

- ✓ Jesus begins a third stage of his ministry by organizing a mission throughout the region. Until then the apostles had accompanied Jesus but now Jesus sends them...
- ✓ Jesus is an educator. Not only does he teach us, but he educates us and engages us in his mission. We must proclaim our faith and perform wonders like our Master. Thus he invites us to put into practice the riches of the Kingdom. That is why we must live day to day, confident in our Father's providence.
