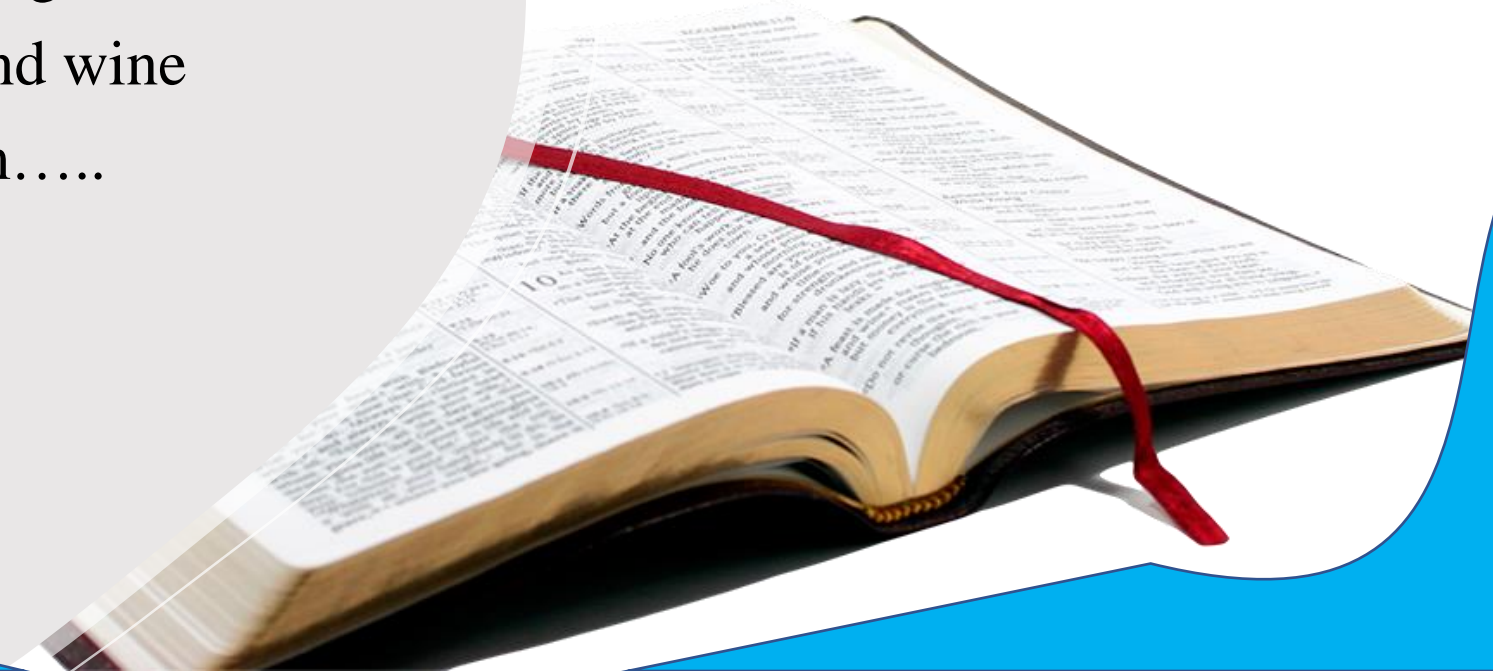

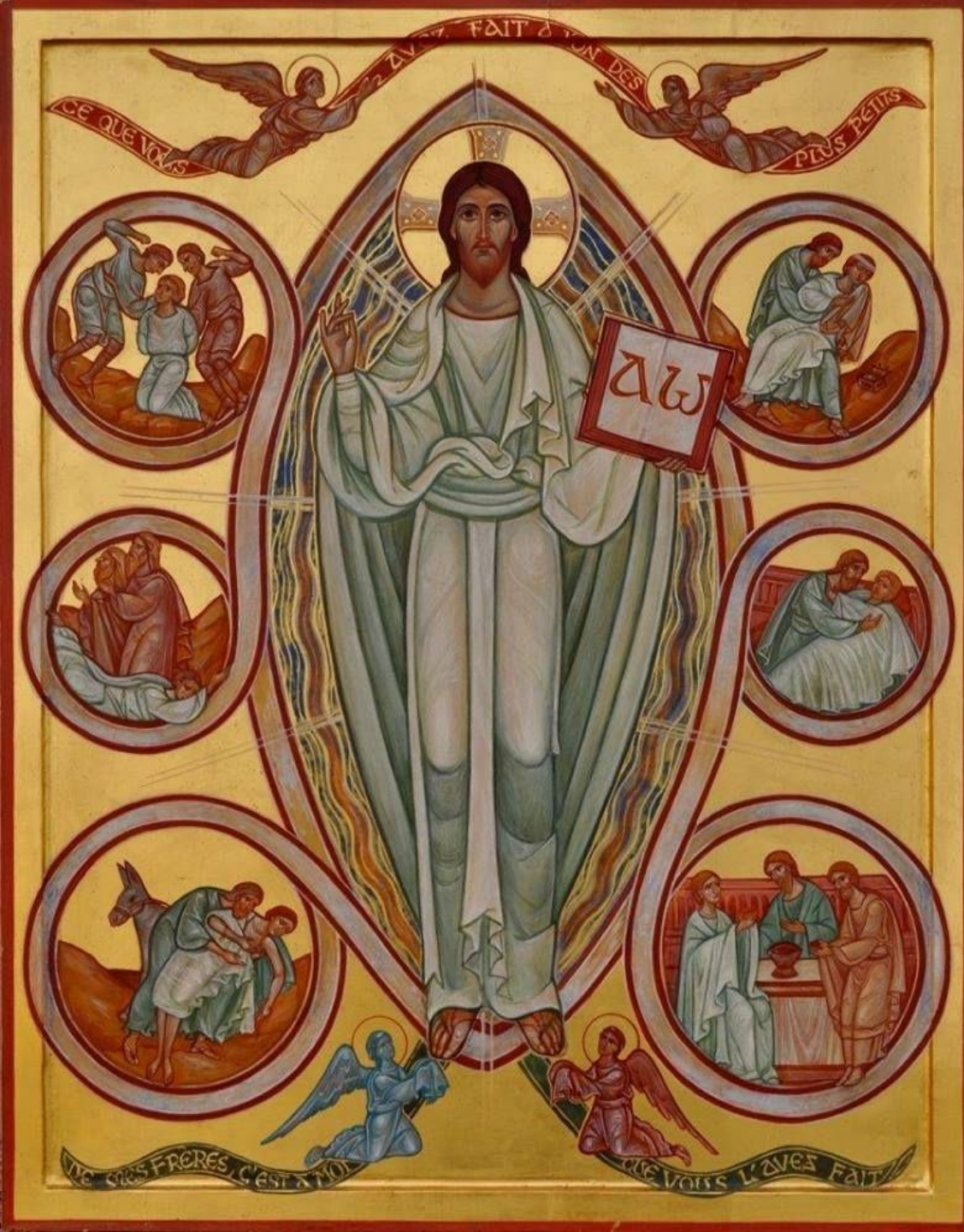


# PERSONAL REFLECTION

How does our reflection affect our understanding of discrimination and racism?



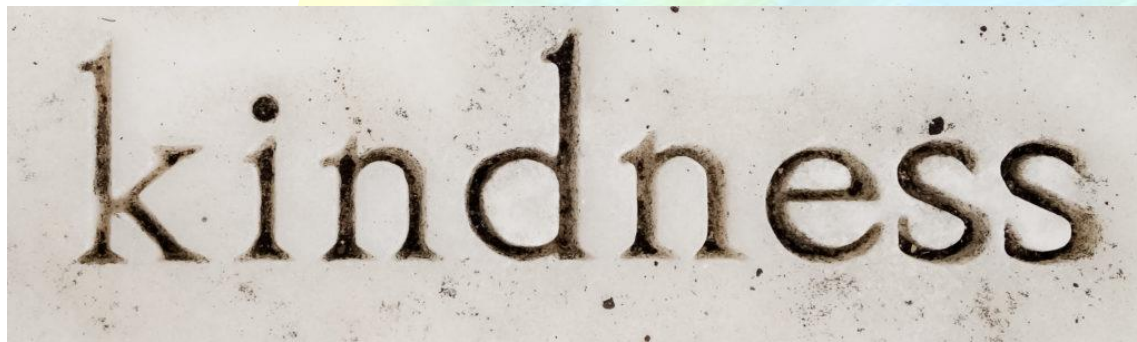
